Specialist Navigator Service (DSVA, SMD)

OUR NAVIGATOR:

- Builds trust and helps overcome barriers for improved long-term outcomes.
- Facilitates a joined up, flexible, women-centred service at the right time and in the right place.
- Offers a trauma-informed initial assessment of each client's needs, strengths, and wishes.
- Co-produces a support plan with the client, including safety planning and developing connections with other services.
- Enables the client to develop her understanding of DSVA risks, perpetrator abuse, and the impact on her needs and on her wider family.
- Works with and supports other service providers to improve wrap-around support.




OUR REFERRAL CRITERIA

Our service is trauma-informed and woman-centred. We aim to deliver a service based on each woman's needs and to support her to make her own choices. Language support is also available.

Women referred to us must be:

- Aged 18 years and over.
- Have previous or current experience of domestic and/or sexual violence and abuse.
- Living in or engaging with temporary or emergency accommodation in Nottingham city.
- Experiencing at least one other SMD criteria: mental ill-health, problematic substance or alcohol use, offending (or a victim of offending).
